Lynda Philpott and Sarah Venamore will be handling sponsorship, both for our October Members Only Championships and the Franz Mairinger. Sonja Veyerman will be coordinating Young Riders, a job that hasn't had a "dedicated" Committee member since Angela Jansz, who initiated it.

Sarah Venamore has agreed to serve Judges' lunches, traditionally part of Elsebeth's Judges' Coordinator role. HOW YOU CAN HELP YOUR CLUB

The day before the event, we do "setting up". This takes an hour or two, depending on how many helpers we have and how much mess has been left by the previous users of the shed. It involves a variety of tasks, such as: putting up signs; getting the tables and chairs ready for the canteen and judges lunches; putting drinks into the fridges; ensuring the shed is presentable, swept etc; checking the loos; having the scoring calculators, pens etc ready in the caravan; and so on.

The day of the event, we need: pencilers, scorers, runners (to collect test papers and take them to scorers), canteen helpers, gear stewards and so on.

If you are competing but would like to help, both Louise and Membership Secretary, Margaret Alcock, will ensure your task does not clash with your warm-up and tests. If you are attending as a "moral supporter", they will ensure your task enables you to get to where you have to be to encourage/watch/film etc. If you would like to help but are not sure what a task involves, (eg gear stewarding, scoring) instructions and support are on hand.

At the upcoming Members Only Club Championships, riders must compete in both tests on offer at their chosen level if they wish to be eligible to win a Championship rug.

Also to be awarded at the Club Championships is the Sally Evans Memorial Trophy. This accolade is awarded each year to the rider UNDER 25 YEARS OF AGE who wins the higher of the two Preliminary tests (this year, the 1.4) and who owns and trains his or her horse.

Sally Evans was a young member of BDC in its early days. Passionate about her riding, she was tragically killed in a car accident at Berrima. Her parents donated a beautiful trophy to the Club and it has been an integral part of the Club Championships ever since.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

COMPETITION DATE: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 7, 2007

It is the responsibility of all competitors to be aware of the rules of this competition. It will be held in accordance with the rules of the EFA and FEI. A copy of the EFA rules can be purchased directly from the EFA or from the EFA website, www.efanational.com

1. Competitors (riders) must be current members of BDC Inc to compete and to be covered by insurance.
2. Closing date for entries: Wednesday, September 19, 2007. Entries numbers are limited, so entries will be logged as received. **Telephone and faxed entries will not be accepted.**
3. Scratchings will be accepted up to 9pm on the day entries close. No refund will be made after that date. A 50% refund will apply only if a doctor/vet certificate is dated and received by the Event Secretary prior to the event. No refund is made to DNAs.
4. Please make cheques/money orders payable to BDC Inc. **Do not send cash.**
5. Time requests from competitors should be noted on the entry form. We try to meet these requests when compiling the draw, but it is not always possible. Times cannot be changed on the day.
6. A copy of the time draw will be sent to competitors who enclose a stamped, self-addressed business-sized envelope. The draw will be sent by email to those who provide an email address. It will also be posted on the BDC website, www.bowraldressage.com.
7. Times will be strictly adhered to. Failure to report to the judge at the appointed time can mean elimination.
8. All competitors must report to the Gear Steward **no more than 15 minutes** prior to each test.
9. In all tests, the rider may be changed by notifying the Event Secretary. **Horses cannot be changed.**
10. Callers are permitted at this competition.
11. Competitors are limited to a maximum of three horses per event. Each rider can compete in no more than six tests. Each horse may compete in no more than three tests at two consecutive levels.
12. Only horses entered in the event can be ridden on the grounds. Only riders who are entered in the competition and have completed a disclaimer can ride on the grounds.
13. Warming up and lunging must be well away from the competition areas. Competitors must not ride in or around arenas in which tests are in progress. Spectators must stay at least 10m away from any arena. You may not warm up in the competition arenas or area.
14. An approved safety helmet and long or short riding boots must be worn, including warming up. Riders should always be correctly attired (including gloves and coat) on presentation to the Gear Steward. Riders without an approved helmet will not be allowed to ride on the ground or compete.
15. All protests must be submitted in writing to The Secretary within 30 minutes of the happening which gave rise to the protest. As per EFA rule 1.3, such written protests must be accompanied by a fee of \$20 which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
16. Neither the organisers nor the owner of the property accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
17. Dogs are not permitted on the grounds by order of the Bong Bong Picnic Race Club. Horses are not permitted on the race track.
