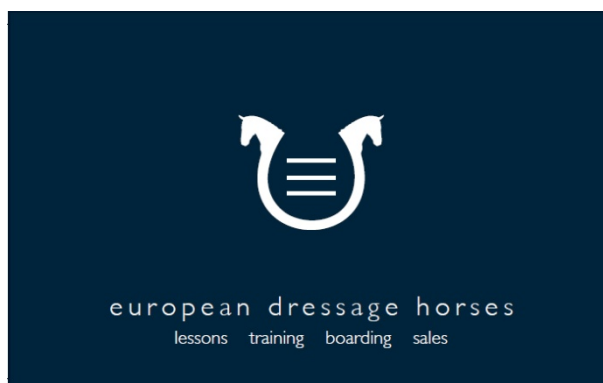

## RULES OF ENTRY

DUE TO THE EFFORT THAT IT TAKES OUR VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE MEMBERS TO PREPARE FOR COMPETITIONS, PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU COMPLETE ENTRY FORMS FULLY AND SUBMIT THEM ON TIME.

UNFORTUNATELY IN THE PAST A SIGNIFICANT NUMBER OF MEMBERS HAVE GIVEN LITTLE CONSIDERATION TO THE WORKLOAD OF THE EVENT SECRETARY, AND AS A RESULT THE FOLLOWING RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO.

### ENTRY FORMS

- COMPETITORS MUST BE CURRENT MEMBERS OF EA OR BDC TO COMPETE.
- IT IS COMPETITORS RESPONSIBILITY TO KNOW THE EA RULES REGARDING ELIGIBILITY FOR ENTRY TO CLASSES, GEAR ETC. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF BDC TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES..
- COMPETITORS ARE LIMITED TO A MAXIMUM OF THREE HORSES PER EVENT. EACH RIDER CAN COMPETE IN NO MORE THAN SIX TESTS. EACH HORSE MAY COMPETE IN NO MORE THAN THREE TESTS AT TWO CONSECUTIVE LEVELS.
- FORMS AND WAIVERS MUST BE COMPLETED FULLY TO COMPLY WITH BDC/EA INSURANCE.
- DO NOT LEAVE ANY INFORMATION OUT: **BRIDLE NUMBERS ARE COMPULSORY** – BRIDLE NUMBERS ARE AVAILABLE FROM EQUESTRIAN AUSTRALIA PH (02) 9620 2660 EMAIL [Susie@efansw.com.au](mailto:Susie@efansw.com.au)
- TIME REQUESTS FOR COMPETITORS SHOULD BE NOTED ON THE ENTRY FORM. WE WILL TRY TO MEET THESE REQUESTS WHEN COMPILING THE DRAW BUT THIS IS NOT ALWAYS POSSIBLE. TIMES CANNOT BE CHANGED ON THE DAY.
- RIDERS ARE TO USE ONLY ONE NAME FOR A HORSE PER BRIDLE NUMBER (IE NOT THEIR STABLE NAME FOR ONE TEST AND THE REGISTERED NAME FOR ANOTHER)
- COMPLETE ENTRY FORMS IN CLEAR AND LEGIBLE TEXT PARTICULARLY EMAIL ADDRESSES. ANY FORMS NOT COMPLETED IN FULL WILL BE REJECTED.
- **CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: WEDNESDAY, 25th AUGUST 2010**
- **POST ENTRIES WITH CHEQUE OR MONEY ORDER TO THE EVENT SECRETARY, PO BOX 628 BOWRAL NSW 2576 DO NOT SEND CASH**
- **LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**
- THE EVENT SECRETARY WILL APPLY ALL RULES EQUALLY TO ENTRIES. ANY COMPLAINTS SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO THE BDC COMMITTEE IN WRITING VIA THE EVENT SECRETARY.
- NO CHANGE OF HORSE IS ALLOWED AFTER ENTRY CLOSING DATE, HOWEVER CHANGE OF RIDER IS PERMISSABLE.

### FEEES

- MEMBER FEES: \$30 ASSOCIATE, OFFICIAL \$35
- NON MEMBER FEES: \$40 ASSOCIATE, OFFICIAL \$45
- ADMINISTRATION FEE/GROUND: \$10 PER RIDER

### SCRATCHINGS

- SCRATCHINGS WILL BE ACCEPTED UP TO 9PM ON THE DAY ENTRIES CLOSE. ENTRY FORM AND ALL FEES WILL BE RETURNED.
- IN THE EVENT OF A SCRATCHING AFTER CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES, ENTRY AND GROUND / ADMIN FEES ARE FORFEITED UNLESS A VET OR DOCTOR'S CERTIFICATE IS SUPPLIED WITHIN 24 HRS OF THE EVENT, IN WHICH CASE 50% OF THE ENTRY FEE PORTION WILL BE REFUNDED, BUT GROUND / ADMIN FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.
- NO REFUND IS MADE TO DNA'S.

### COMPETITION CANCELLATION

- IN THE EVENT OF THE COMPETITION BEING CANCELLED DUE TO WEATHER , ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED. GROUND / ADMIN FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE AS THEY ARE USED TO COVER COSTS INCURRED BY THE CLUB.

### REFUNDS

- REFUNDS ARE RETURNED ELECTRONICALLY TO THE ORIGINAL CHEQUE ACCOUNT IF FEES PAID BY CHEQUE OR MADE OUT TO THE RIDER NOMINATED ON THE ENTRY FORM UNLESS ADDITIONAL DETAILS TO THE CONTRARY ARE PROVIDED ON THE ENTRY FORM.

## COMPETITION RULES

**COMPETITION DATE: SUNDAY, 19<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2010**

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ALL COMPETITORS TO BE AWARE OF THE RULES OF THIS COMPETITION. IT WILL BE HELD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF THE EA AND FEI. A COPY OF THE EA RULES CAN BE PURCHASED DIRECTLY FROM THE EA OR FROM THE EA WEBSITE, [WWW.EFANATIONAL.COM](http://WWW.EFANATIONAL.COM)

- **COMPETITORS MUST BE CURRENT MEMBERS OF EA OR BDC INC TO COMPETE.**
- AN APPROVED SAFETY HELMET AND LONG OR SHORT RIDING BOOTS MUST BE WORN,
- INCLUDING WARMING UP, RIDERS SHOULD ALWAYS BE CORRECTLY ATTIRED (INCLUDING GLOVES AND COAT) ON PRESENTATION TO THE GEAR STEWARD. RIDERS WITHOUT AN APPROVED HELMET WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RIDE ON THE GROUND OR COMPETE.
- WARMING UP AND LUNGING MUST BE WELL AWAY FROM THE COMPETITION AREAS. COMPETITORS MUST NOT RIDE IN OR AROUND ARENAS IN WHICH TESTS ARE IN PROGRESS.
- SPECTATORS MUST STAY AT LEAST 10M AWAY FROM ANY ARENA. YOU MAY NOT WARM UP IN THE COMPETITION ARENAS OR AREA.
- ALL COMPETITORS **MUST** REPORT TO THE GEAR STEWARD **NO MORE THAN** 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO EACH TEST.
- TIMES WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO. FAILURE TO REPORT TO THE JUDGE AT THE APPOINTED TIME CAN MEAN ELIMINATION.
- CALLERS ARE **NOT** PERMITTED AT THIS COMPETITION.
- ALL PROTESTS MUST BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING TO THE SECRETARY WITHIN 30 MINUTES OF THE HAPPENING WHICH GAVE RISE TO THE PROTEST. AS PER EA RULE 1.3, SUCH WRITTEN PROTESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A FEE OF \$20 WHICH WILL BE REFUNDED IF THE PROTEST IS UPHELD.
- REGISTERED PONIES MAY NOW COMPETE IN ALL OFFICIAL CLASSES. THEY MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE EA, HAVE A CURRENT GRADING CARD AND HAVE PROOF OF MEASUREMENT BEING 149CM OR LESS (WITH SHOES). RIDERS OF PONIES IN OFFICIAL COMPETITIONS MUST TURN 10 IN THE CALENDAR YEAR OF COMPETITION. DRESSAGE RULE 1.12.4
- NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS BY ORDER OF BONG BONG PICNIC RACE CLUB.
- NO HORSES ARE TO BE RIDDEN AT A BDC COMPETITION UNLESS THEY ARE ENTERED IN THE COMPETITION AND THEY HAVE COMPLETED A DISCLAIMER.
- NEITHER THE ORGANISERS NOR THE OWNER OF THE PROPERTY ACCEPTS ANY LIABILITY FOR ANY ACCIDENT, DAMAGE, INJURY OR ILLNESS TO HORSES, OWNERS, SPECTATORS OR ANY OTHER PERSON OR PROPERTY WHATSOEVER.
- UNAUTHORISED VEHICLES ARE NOT PERMITTED TO CROSS THE RACETRACK AND MUST REMAIN IN CAR/FLOAT AREA.
- **IN THE INTEREST OF HEALTH AND SAFETY ANY RIDER WHO FALLS FROM THEIR HORSE AT THE EVENT WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO RE-MOUNT AGAIN.**
