Conditions of Entry

Please read carefully.

- This training competition may be judged by persons who are not EA accredited judges but by suitably experienced people who in the Club's opinion, are most worthy of being appointed for the task.
- Neither the organiser nor the owner of the grounds accepts any liability for any accidents, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person whatsoever.
- No telephone entries will be accepted. Scratchings will be accepted up until 9.00pm on the day entries close. No refund will be made after this date.
- Entries will only be accepted if the entry form is filled out and signed correctly with the correct payment included.
- In some circumstances, entries may be limited.
- Please note that the Preparatory and/or the Preliminary tests may have to be ridden in a 20m x 40m arena. Entrants will be notified on the time draw if this is the case.
- **BRC Inc Preparatory tests** may be found on our club website (see below) – "Disciplines" tab
- **The time draw will be emailed to competitors and posted on our website just prior to the competition day.**

- Or, if you don't have an email address, please enclose a **stamped self-addressed business-size envelope** for the return of the time draw.
- This competition will be held in accordance with the EA rules where applicable.
- This competition is open to horses, galloways, ponies.
- Horses may compete in two consecutive levels (e.g. Prel/Nov, Nov/Elem), but no more than three tests per horse.
- One rider may only ride a maximum of two horses per event.
- Parents must sign for riders under 18 years.
- Callers are permitted.
- While riding on the grounds an Australian approved helmet and correct riding boots must be worn otherwise elimination will occur.
- **Whips** must not exceed 1.2m in total length, **gloves must be worn** in all tests and all parts of **bits** coming into the horses mouth must be made of one metal, or metal and rubber, or metal and synthetic.
- The committee's decision is final.
- **Riders & horses** on the grounds must be entered in the dressage competition and are members of the Berry Riding Club Inc or the EA.

Special "Conditions of Entry" for this Championship

- This event is open to riders under 24 as at the 30th December 2010, on horses or ponies of any height.
- Entrants who are non-members of Berry Riding Club Inc may join BRC Inc as a restricted member (\$15) or, must be members of the EFA and their horse registered with the EA.
- Rugs will be 'made to measure' after the event and sent to the winning riders.
- There will be no equal placings. A countback will take place starting with the mark for Rider on the test sheets.
- All placegetters are asked to assemble in the 'Shed' 1 hour after the last horse in their test has finished competing to receive their awards and to have photos taken. Neat & tidy attire a must.
