All the years in the planning....and our beautiful new sand arenas are a great success! The consensus from riders who competed on them on April 22 was: "They're going to bed down really well".

The competition saw 71 competitors riding a total of 152 tests. Official tests were ridden on two of the new arenas, with up to five riders at a time warming up on the third.

The significant rain experienced by the Southern Highlands prior to the competition was a good tryout, and the base held up perfectly. Qualms were expressed by test riders on April 13 and 16 about the concrete surrounds being sharp on the edges. This issue could not be addressed in time for the competition on April 22, but - weather permitting - they will soon be turned over to present a bevelled edge. At the same time, the arenas will be laser-levelled as part of the "bedding down" process.

For the grass arenas, it is a little early to comment on the results of the seeding and fertilising that has taken place so far. Again, depending on the weather, our next comp on June 10 may give us more feedback.

All in all, April 22 was a very successful and busy competition. Set-up saw three of our new Junior members (Isabella, Olivia and Charlotte Lalak) helping with the arena letters. The canteen did a roaring trade, manned by new member (and Intermediate rider), Nick Wasiliev. We're now looking forward to BDC's next comp being an even better day. COMPETITION DATE: SUNDAY, JUNE 10, 2007

It is the responsibility of all competitors to be aware of the rules of this competition. It will be held in accordance with the rules of the EFA and FEI. A copy of the EFA rules can be purchased directly from the EFA or from the EFA website, www.efanational.com

1. Competitors (riders) must be current members of BDC Inc or the EFA to compete and to be covered by insurance.
2. Closing date for entries: Friday May 18, 2007. Entries numbers are limited, so entries will be logged as received. **Telephone and faxed entries will not be accepted.**
3. Scratchings will be accepted up to 9pm on the day entries close. No refund will be made after that date. A 50% refund will apply only if a doctor/vet certificate is dated and received by the Event Secretary prior to the event. No refund is made to DNAs.
4. Please make cheques/money orders payable to BDC Inc. **Do not send cash.**
5. Time requests from competitors should be noted on the entry form. We try to meet these requests when compiling the draw, but it is not always possible. Times cannot be changed on the day.
6. A copy of the time draw will be sent to competitors who enclose a stamped, self-addressed business-sized envelope. The draw will be sent by email to those who provide an email address. It will also be posted on the BDC website, www.bowraldressage.com.
7. Times will be strictly adhered to. Failure to report to the judge at the appointed time can mean elimination.
8. All competitors must report to the Gear Steward **no more than** 15 minutes prior to each test.
9. In all tests, the rider may be changed by notifying the Event Secretary. **Horses cannot be changed.**
10. Callers are permitted at this competition.
11. Competitors are limited to a maximum of three horses per event. Each rider can compete in no more than six tests. Each horse may compete in no more than three tests at two consecutive levels.
12. Only horses entered in the event can be ridden on the grounds. Only riders who are entered in the competition and have completed a disclaimer can ride on the grounds.
13. Warming up and lunging must be well away from the competition areas. Competitors must not ride in or around arenas in which tests are in progress. Spectators must stay at least 10m away from any arena. You may not warm up in the competition arenas or area.
14. An approved safety helmet and long or short riding boots must be worn, including during warming up. Riders should always be correctly attired (including gloves and coat) on presentation to the Gear Steward. Riders without an approved helmet will not be allowed to ride or compete.
15. All protests must be submitted in writing to The Secretary within 30 minutes of the happening which gave rise to the protest. As per EFA rule 1.3, such written protests must be accompanied by a fee of \$20 which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
16. Neither the organisers nor the owner of the property accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
17. Dogs are not permitted on the grounds by order of the Bong Bong Picnic Race Club. Horses are not permitted on the race track.
